- We have received phone calls from members of the public reporting dangerous and irresponsible driving and parking in the area around the school. Please adhere to the 20 mile an hour speed limit when driving around the school perimeter. The guidelines below are to help with parking congestion around the school.

To help make the parking in and around the school easier we are asking parents to use the following guidelines:

- The car park in front of the school is for teachers and official visitors to the school only. Please do not park on the staff car park for dropping off or collecting your children.

- Please do not park in the car park by the shops.

If you have difficulty parking around the school, please use the car park at The Village Hall off Burberry Road, which is a short 5 minute walk to the school.

The local PCSO has been informed of the complaints and will be patrolling the area around the school at various times.

- Should the school be faced with closure due to adverse weather conditions we will put notices on the school website, the school Facebook page and send notice via Parentmail to inform parents of the school's status. Please bear in mind that a decision to close in extreme weather is the last resort. We need to take into account health and safety issues in and around the school in freezing weather, along with the fact that many of our staff commute and we need to ensure their safety in travelling to and from work.
