SDG 6 Clean Water and Sanitation

We will be learning about the importance of conserving water and its importance on our health.

In English...

We will be focusing on writing a newspaper article and a narrative in our new CLPE class text. We will be applying basic punctuation and developing our independent writing including the use of conjunctions.

In Maths...

We will be focusing on multiplication and division, focusing on number facts of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We will learn how to show these facts and solve calculations using arrays.

In Science...

We will be learning about the importance of hygiene, everyday materials and food chains.

In History...

We will be learning about Sir Joseph William Bazalgette and the history of the sewerage system.

In Art...

We will be creating images using a variety of different media.

In PE...

We will be learning about the rules in Netball and some simple Gymnastic movements.

In Computing...

We will be learning common uses of technology, how to use emails and recognise acceptable behaviour online.

In French...

We will be learning about colours through our superheroes.

In Online Safety...

We will learn how to manage information online including privacy and security.

In Geography...

We will be learning about and comparing local water sources, including locating them on a map.

We will be researching, designing and making levers and sliders.

In Religious Education...

We will be learning how to compose and perform using instruments to make sounds of the sea.
