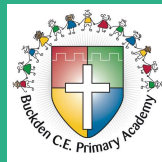




# YEAR 5

### In English

We are reading: *When the sky falls* by Phil Earle  
Our spellings include daily practise to be tested on Monday morning.



### Global development Goal: Zero Hunger

We will be exploring the question:  
How as a nation can we address hunger across the world?

### In Maths

Our topics include:  
properties of shape  
position and direction  
converting units



### In Science

Our topic is: Living things and their environments. This includes being able to identify similarities and differences between the life cycles of a mammal, amphibian, insect and bird



### In RE

We are focusing on People of God and the question: How can following God bring freedom and justice. This involves the story of Moses.



### In PE

### In Geography

We will be looking at where food is produced across the world and why some kinds cannot be grown in this country. We will look at why land is chosen for different uses.



### In History

We are working on our songs for our school play - singing ensemble.
