Welcome to our class newsletter for this half term. We are excited to share with you our learning journey.

In English...

We will be using a CLPE book to explore a different version of a well-known fairy tale. We will take an in-depth look at character description and their relationships. We will also be using our inferencing skills and predication skills.

We will be learning about how to eradicate poverty.

In Computing...

We will be learning how to use graphics, animations and sound to generate an information pack in Power point.

In Maths...

We will be looking at the relationship between decimals and fractions. We will continue to practice our multiplication tables. There will also be a focus of reading the time and using money.

In Science...

This half term, we will be learning about electricity and finding out about circuits and conductors.

In French...

We will be looking at different sculptors and experimenting with clay to create a clay pot using pinch and coil techniques.

In Religious Education...

We will continue to look at Sikhism and learn more about the Gurus and their teachings.

In Music...

We will be looking at music in films and identify some of the common features. We will also look to compose a piece of music ourselves.

In PE...

We will be using our skill set to develop a sequence of actions and developing our flexibility, strength and control.

We will continue to look at money management, how we can buy items and services and what we spend our money on. We will also be looking at the human lifecycle.
