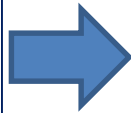
Slums



What are slums?
A slum is a highly populated urban residential area consisting of densely packed housing units of weak build quality and often associated with poverty.



People move to cities in search of work or after losing their homes and livelihoods following disasters fuelled by climate change.



Housing has become too expensive for many.



Bangladesh is home to nearly 160 million people. UNICEF estimates there are 4 million slum dwellers in Dhaka. Three in four slum households live in one room, often lacking access to clean water, safe sanitation and waste management.
