

Charles Darwin.

Darwin travelled on HMS Beagle in 1831 to South America and the Galapagos Islands. He was the ship's Naturalist and his job was to explore, collect and record information about rocks, plants and animals.









In 1859, he wrote a famous book; The Origin of Species, about all of the things he discovered.

He had the idea that plants and creatures hadn't always been the same, had gradually changed over time, and he called this idea evolution.

Some people disagree with Darwin's ideas. Some argue that God created us as fully

formed humans.
