An 'Out of class' pass to let me leave when I feel I need to

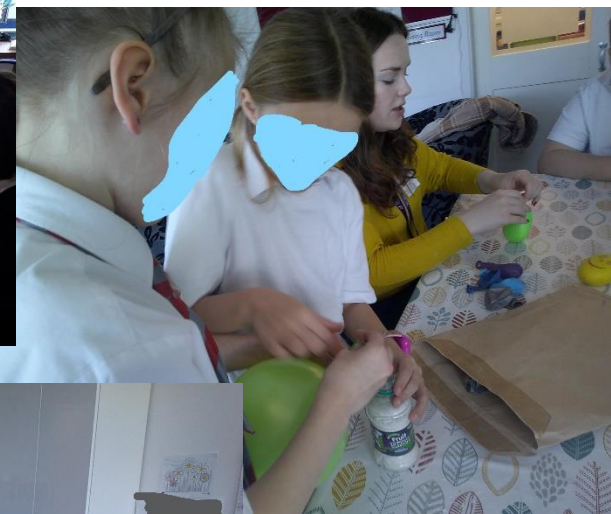
Be aware I am a Young Carer but please don't tell my friends

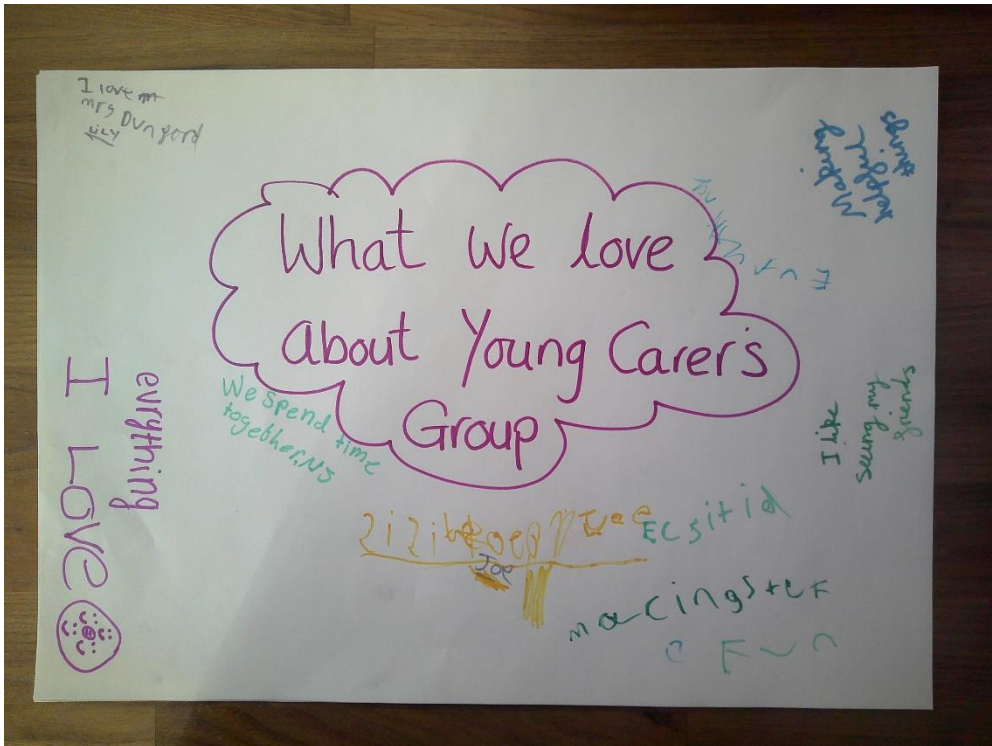

Our Group Sessions

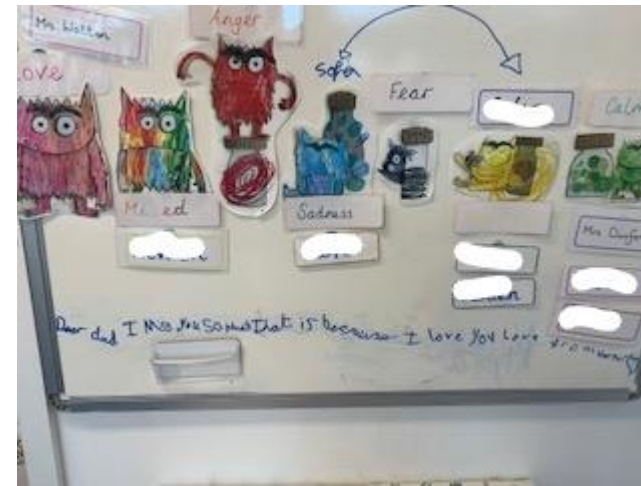


The Hub is our place to meet and where we have our group sessions.

As a school we expect our Young Carers to:	What we will do as a school
Take part as much as possible in lessons and activities offered in school	<p>Ensure that once a year, our Young Carers have the opportunity to communicate with school and share their experiences and awareness of being a Young Carer.</p> <p>We will have regular awareness training for all school staff and where permission is granted, share their circumstances and needs with class Teachers and other support staff.</p>
Let us know the issues that prevent you from completing homework	<p>Allow extended deadlines for reading and homework. Provide daily access to homework lunchtime club to complete homework/projects in school. Ensure that no sanctions are placed on Young Carers for not meeting deadlines.</p>
Tell us what's changing at home that may affect you	<p>The Hub will provide a safe place for you to talk through changes and worries you have about home and family and where needed, contact home for you on your behalf.</p>
Let us know if you need further support	<p>The HSH has three dedicated members of staff who are on hand for you to contact throughout the day. We meet together as Young Carers on Wednesday lunchtimes for you to check-in with adults and other Young Carers, play games and access arts and craft (mindfulness activities)</p> <p>The Soft Start Breakfast Club is always available to you and offers you a time to talk before you enter class. Our drop in letter box is also available to you to send us a private note to talk.</p>
