Christians believe...

- Jesus builds a bridge between God and humans.
- Jesus did more than teach people how to live and behave; he also showed how to live.
- Jesus died to 'save' us, to pay the price of sin in the world and reunite people with God.
- God has the power to forgive sins.



Holy week begins with Palm Sunday.

People welcomed Jesus to Jerusalem by throwing down their cloaks and waving palm branches.



Maundy Thursday: The Last Supper

Jesus taught that he came not to be served but to serve and shared a meal with his disciples.



Good Friday

Jesus was crucified. He died in the afternoon. His body was taken from the cross and put into a guarded tomb.



Easter Sunday

Jesus resurrects from the dead.




The triumphal entry into Jerusalem


The Garden of Gethsemane and Peter's denial



The trial of Jesus




Jesus is crucified
