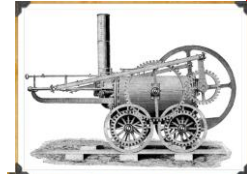
Expansion of the Railways and The Industrial Revolution

1807

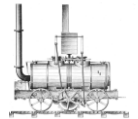
The Oystermouth Railway opens. It transports passengers along tramways on horse-drawn carriages.

The Middleton Railway opens. It transports coal using a steam-powered locomotive.

1825

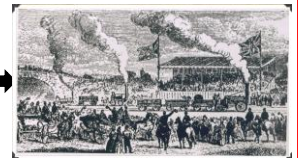
The Stockton and Darlington Railway opens. It is the first steam-powered passenger railway.



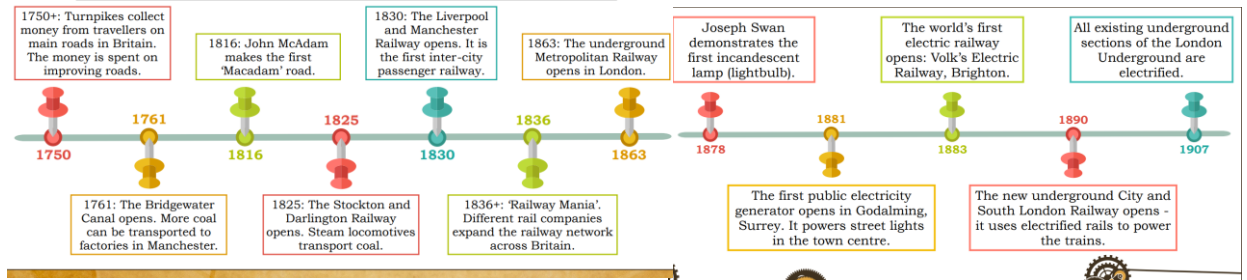
The Rainhill Trials
