Prior Learning (What we already know?):

- To be able to explain how other people's identity online can be different to their identity in real life.
- To be able to describe ways in which people might make themselves look different online.
- To give examples of issues online that might make me feel sad, worried, uncomfortable or frightened; I can give examples of how I might get help

• Key Questions:

What is identity?

- How can our identities be different?
- When would we want to change our identity (online and in real life)?
- Why would acting one way be the right decision in different situations?

Key Facts:

Online identity (id) – is someone's online details – this could be a real or made up person.

Personal data – information about your life which should be kept secret, e.g., your name, birthday, address, your school and passwords.

Good online citizen – being respectful and not hurting other people online.

Worries – any worries about internet or gaming issues – tell your adult or teacher.

New Learning:

- To be able to explain how my online identity can be different to the identity I present in 'real life'.
- Knowing this, be able to describe the right decisions about how I interact with others and how others perceive me.
