Geographic features are features of the Earth, natural or not. Natural geographical features consist of landforms and ecosystems. For example, terrain types (physical factors of the environment) are natural geographical features.

Human features refer to things around us that are built by humans, their physical characteristics include landforms, climate, soils, and hydrology.
