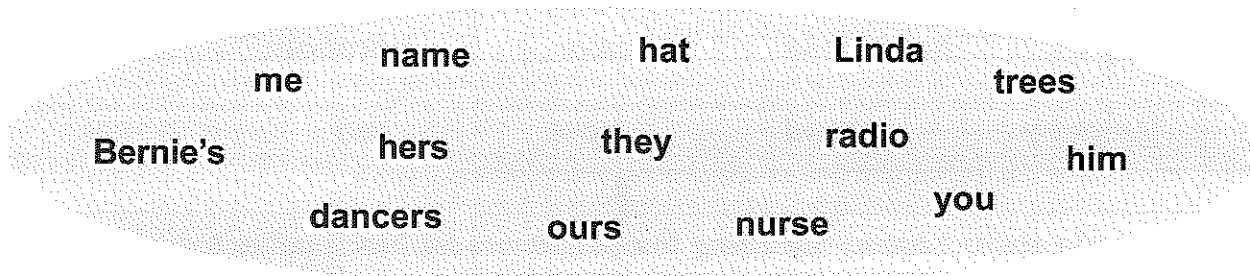




# Pronouns
