We will be learning about

In English...
we will be focusing on writing short narratives based around the journey of a river. We will continue to use our phonological knowledge to help us write simple sentences.



In Computing...
we will be learning how to make and record sounds using technology.



In Maths...
we will be learning about number and place value to 20, including adding and subtracting numbers within 20 using different methods and resources.



In Science...
we will be learning about the five animal groups and their features.



In French...
we will be learning to count to 10 and how to say our age.



In Online Safety...

In Geography...
about the five oceans and seas around the United Kingdom.

In History...
we will be learning about Captain James Cook and his Voyage across the Atlantic Ocean!

In Art...
we will be learning about printing and dying materials and fabrics.



In Music...
we will be learning how to play tuned and untuned instruments.

we will be learning how to stay physically and emotionally safe online.

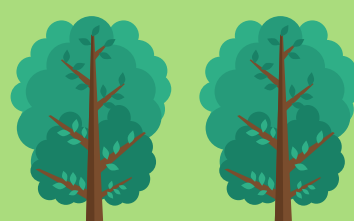
