




Weekly Round-up

Following on from last week we have some more winners to announce from Buckden Primary for the Buckden Roundabout Christmas Cover competition.




The overall winner and winner in the 7 and under category was our very own Ella from Reception with her younger brother Jack!

For each eligible pupil, they will be issuing a £30 supermarket voucher.




Eligibility remains the same as in previous rounds including support for post 16 bursary students. Every eligible pupil
