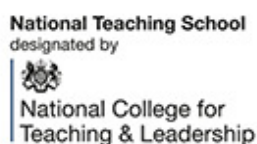

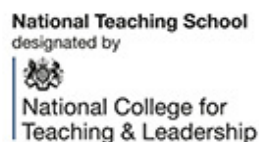
The aim behind the day is to raise the aspirations of our children and for them to understand the opportunities open to them in a wide range of professions.
