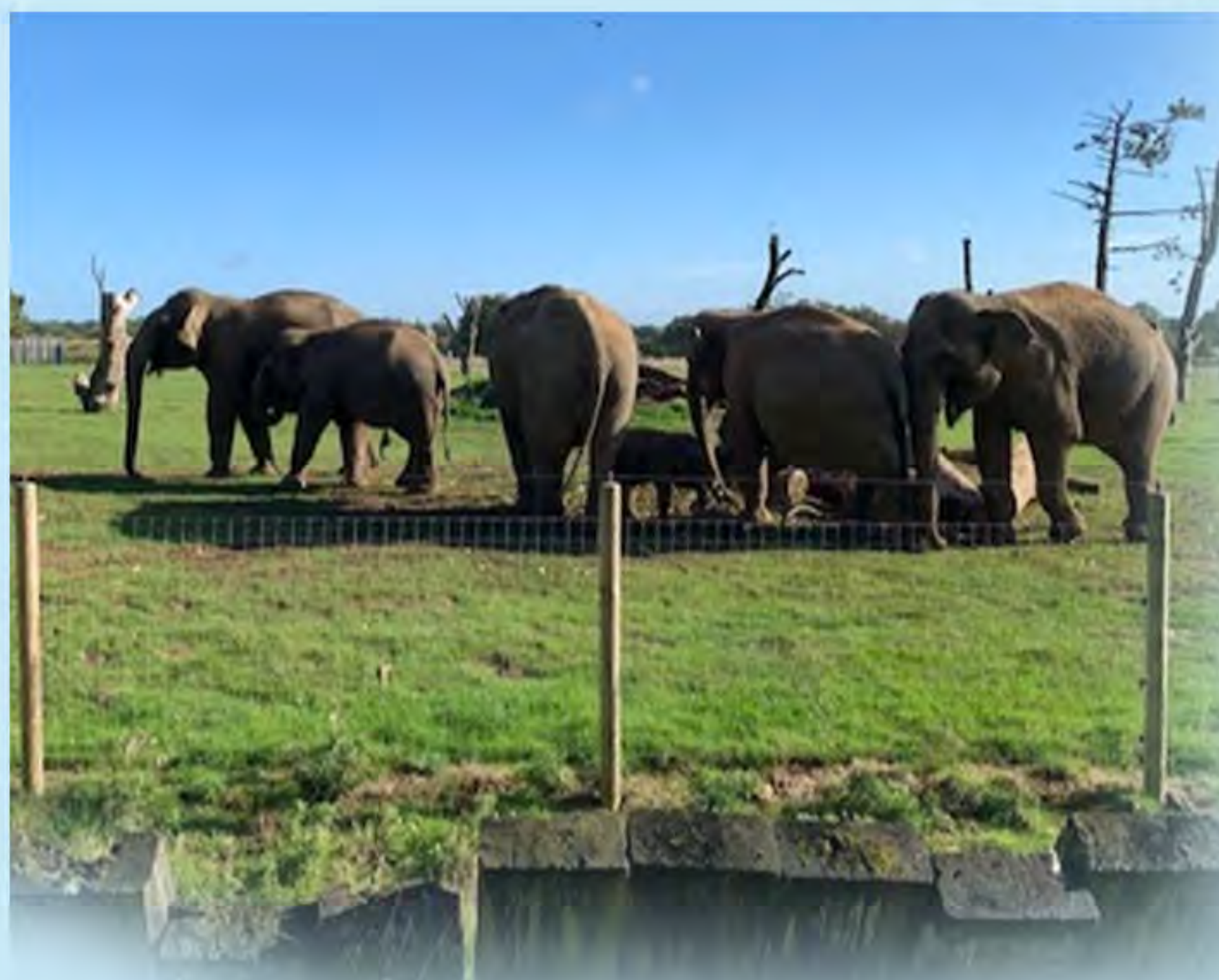




Weekly Round-up
