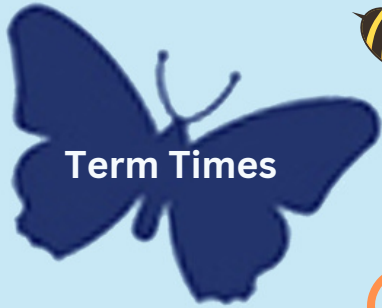

A big thank you to everyone that made a donation, as the money raised will help fund future science resources for the school.



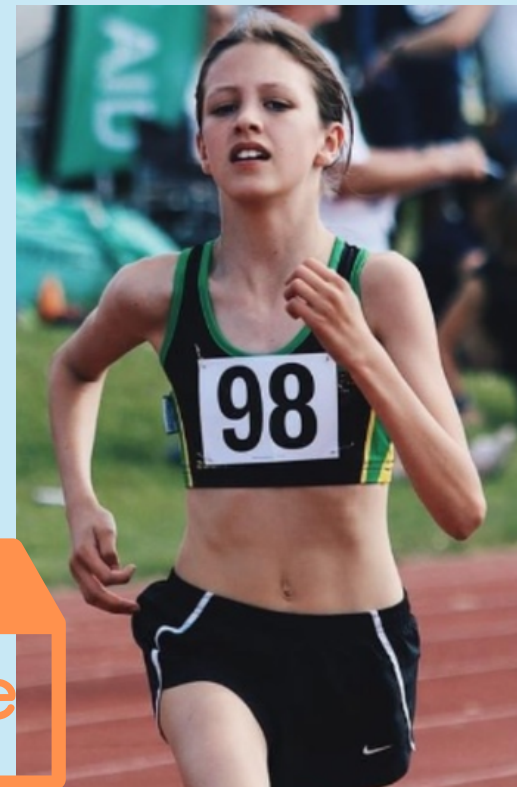


Buckden School Choir have received a special invitation to sing on Saturday 22nd June at St Mary's Church, to help celebrate the Buckden Open Gardens Day.

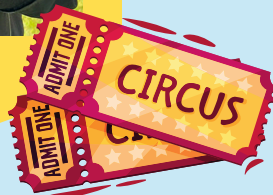
